How to Change Your Apple ID

What You'll Need First

- Access to the email address you want to use as your new Apple ID.
- · Your current Apple ID password.
- · Your new email password.

On an iPhone or iPad

- 1. Open the Settings app.
- 2. Tap Your Name at the top of the screen.
- 3. Select Sign-In & Security.
- 4. Tap Apple ID. (You may be asked to enter your password.)
- 5. Enter the New Email Address you want to use. Apple will send a verification code to that email.
- 6. Check Your Email and enter the code when prompted.
- 7. Your Apple ID is now updated!

On a Mac

- 1. Go to System Settings (or System Preferences on older Macs).
- 2. Click your name (Apple ID) in the sidebar.
- 3. Select Sign-In & Security.
- 4. Click the + sign.
- 5. Enter the new email address.
- 6. Verify with the code Apple sends to your new email.

On the Web

- 1. Visit appleid.apple.com and sign in.
- 2. Click Sign-In.
- 3. Enter the 2FA code sent to your phone.
- 4. Select Email & Phone Numbers in the Sign-In and Security page.
- 5. Click the circle icon beside primary email to change to the new email address.
- 6. Verify with the code Apple sends to your new email.

Tip: If your Apple ID is linked to an iCloud email (like @icloud.com), the iCloud address will be changed to a alias for your new Apple ID.
